"Sandwich" Doctoral Scholarship | 2022-2023

The Israel Council for Higher Education (CHE) and Bar-Ilan University invite you to apply to the "Sandwich Program," which attracts high-achieving doctoral students from universities around the world to do one year of research in Israel as part of their PhD studies.

You will join a select group of individuals who have already completed the program!

Eligibility, Duration and Funding

- Eligible candidates are those who are studying for a PhD in a university outside of Israel, and have successfully completed their first year of studies.
- The scholarship funds part of the candidate's PhD work in Israel, for up to one year (a minimum of three months).
- For a full academic year, the value of the scholarship is NIS 80,000.
- Candidates may begin their period of study in Israel from October 1, 2022.
- Candidates must obtain consent from their home supervisor.
- Candidates must also obtain consent from the potential hosting supervisor at Bar-Ilan University.

Supporting Documents

- Curriculum vitae
- Short letter of intent declaring the candidate's plans and the expected impact of doing research in Israel. In addition, candidates must affirm their commitment to return to their home university.
- Letter of consent from a potential hosting supervisor at Bar-Ilan University.
- Two letters of recommendation, including a letter from the candidate's PhD supervisor.
- Applications must be received by July 31 2022
